REVENUE

Would like to take balance that doesn't come in out of the Fire Department budget. Increase in CHIPS Increase in mortgage tax \$2000

The clerk would like to take Deputy Clerks salary out of general and put into sewer fund. Most of what DC does is sewer related in addition to what the Clerk Treasurer does with sewer fund. The general fund has always paid for this. She will check with comptroller on legality of this.

Mayor would like the Clerk /Treasure to break down what salary would be for Clerk and for Treasurer if the board were to split the title into two separate positions. Also duties list for the two Mayor would like to have a replacement for current clerk to start sometime in December 2018.
