5:00pm Superintendent Rich Scavo and Assistant Charlie Harrison were present to review the DPW proposed budget!!!!!!!

Mayor Ingalls asked if he could prioritize the need of replacement for the equipment listed in the proposal.

- 1) Ferris Mower
- 2) P/U Truck
- 3) Masey Tractor

Superintendent Scavo informed the board that the CHIPS Program may be discontinued by the Federal Budget. He will keep them informed as he receives more information.

Superintendent Scavo asked the board to consider a \$3,000.00 "bonus" similar to what was done last spring to assist with defraying the cost of his health insurance premium. He also asked the board to consider an additional amount in the 2024-2025 budget to assist with health insurance as well. \$1,500.00 out of the general account and \$1,500.00 from the sewer account.

The board discussed at this time the need to consider raising the cost of the sewer rents again. Currently sewer rent quarterly is \$35.00. The board discussed the possibility of raising the sewer rent to \$40.00 but no decision was made at this time.
