FIRE DEPT.

The report of the fire department was approved on a motion by W, Coleman, second by G. Thomas and carried.

Fire Chief Chick reported a need to replace our current tanker/pumper a 1979 GMC, it was originally a ten-wheel dump truck and we have replaced the tanks on the back and it is in bad shape. Cost to replace that tanker could be \$180,000.

There is a truck that is being retired in the Montour Falls district as they received a FEMA grant to replace the tanker. The tanker is a 1979 ford and is all equipped and we can purchase it for a cost of \$5000.00 and it should last seven to ten years.

Mayor Terry noted that we have \$3600.00 in the fire equipment account and questioned if they would need any other equipment

Fire Chief Chick does not see that we will need any other equipment. We can put the present tanker out to bid and we might possibly get \$1000.00 to \$1500.00 for it. I request that the village purchase this tanker.

Motion to approve the purchase was made by W. McNelis, second by J. Falci and carried.

DPW REPORT

Superintendent of Public Works Zdanowski noted that the pressure test of the new sewer force main has been completed and it has increased our capacity for sewage pumping by 20%. Mr. Zdanowski was instructed to look into the cost of cleaning out the old sewer line that still can be used.
